PURPOSE: UCI has provided a comprehensive repository of training materials to support your transition into the new UCPath system. In this guide, you will learn about the various learning tools available to employees within the UCI UCPath website, and the UC Learning Management System (UCLC). Curriculum:

The employee curriculums available are a series of instructional courses, which have been assigned based employee job responsibilities at UCI.

- Curriculums are the main reference tool for the structure and order of training that is required.
- Courses within the curriculum vary in delivery method and availability.
- Courses offered in each curriculum may use both instructor led, and web-based delivery methods.

Instructor Led Courses (ILT) & Registration:

Instructor Led Courses are in-person classroom sessions that provide important detailed information and engage participants in meaningful discussions.

- Sessions are conducted live, on-site, or online, by a knowledgeable UCPath Trainer. There are multiple times and dates for each instructor led UCPath course.
- Employees login to the UC Learning Center (UCLC), search for the desired course, and register on the best available date and time. Users can type “UCPath” in search bar to filter results.
- Seating availability will be limited, please ensure prompt registration for all assigned instructor-led “Core” classes, based on curriculum. Employees will be put on the waiting list if selected session is at capacity.

These are self-paced, online training courses that are conveniently available to employees 24/7.

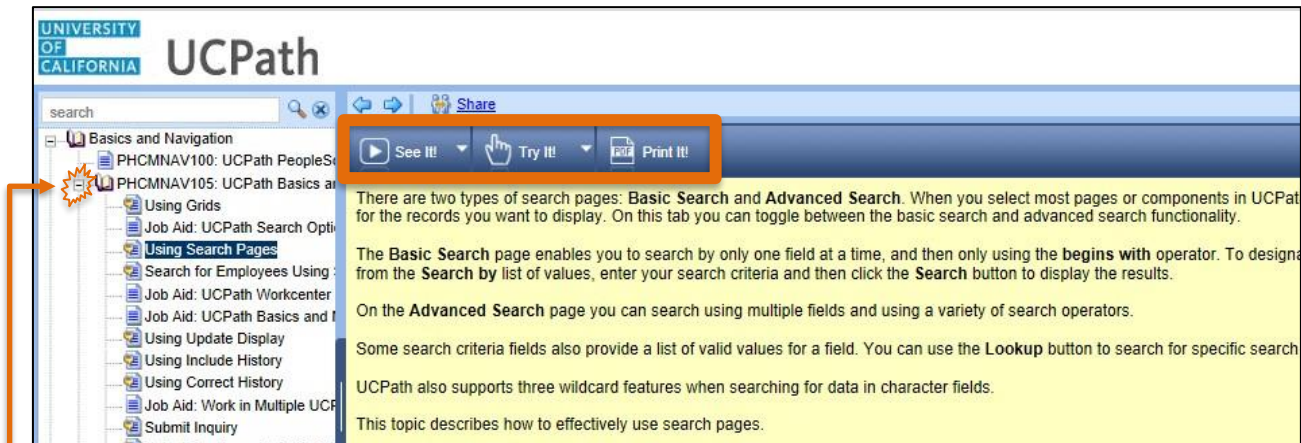
There are two (2) UCPath Help Sites:

1. UCPath Help Site for [Employee Self-Service](#) and [Manager Self-Service](#) actions.
2. UCPath Help site for [Location Users](#) that enter HR and Finance transactions.

(The employee's security access determines which help site library will be available.)

The Help Sites can be accessed via the Help option in the upper right of UCPath.

There are **three (3) different view modes** that are available to deploy within the UCPath Help Site:



TIP: Click the Plus (+) icon to expand the Purple books, then click on a topic to access the **See It!**, **Try It!** and **Print It!** buttons.

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- **See it! Mode:** Is a step-by-step video simulation, which demonstrates an example of how to execute the topic selected.
- **Try It! Mode:** A guided, hands-on learning experience that allows the user to participate through virtual instruction.
- **Print It! Mode:** Allows the end-user to print out a step-by-step guide (job aid) that can be utilized or referenced in the work place.
